Summertime is a great time to catch some rays and help your body naturally make Vitamin D. While outside the ultraviolet rays in sunlight stimulate your body to make vitamin D. Expose bare skin to the sun for only a few minutes a day outside. Sunscreen should be worn after a few minutes only of bare skin sun exposure. You can get this vitamin D from food too, and supplements. Buy vitamin fortified foods such as milk or cereal, and eat fatty fish like tuna or salmon. Vitamin D helps us absorb calcium from food and maintain a healthy immune and nervous system.
