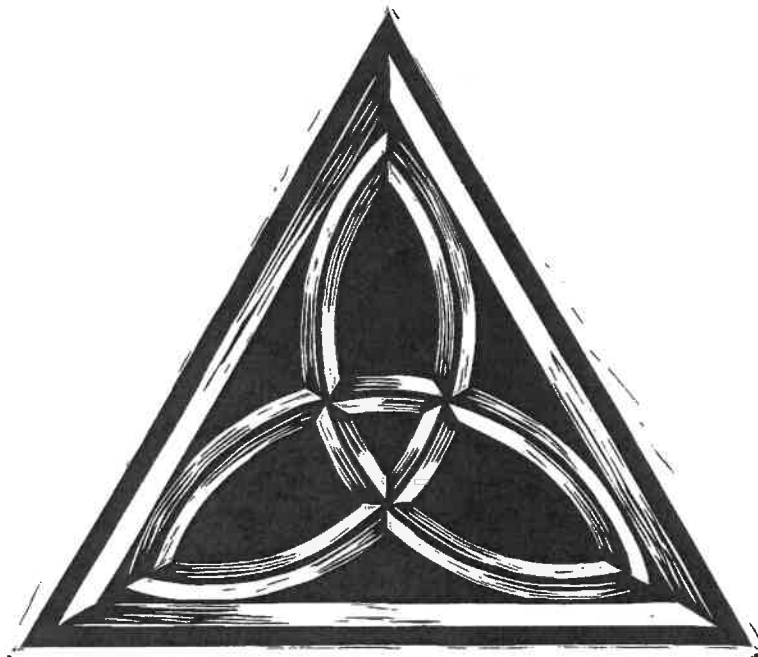

FROM PARISH HEALTH *Equipment Update:*

A new **Automated External Defibrillator (AED)** should arrive this month. It can be a stressful situation if the need to use it arrives and it's so important to know how to use it. It does give clear instructions once turned on but actually seeing and practicing it even once yearly can make a big difference on an outcome. It often will save a life on a witnessed cardiac arrest. Darlene would like to attend most of the church's group activities to give a brief review on CPR and how it works.

First Aid Kits - Three first aid kits have been purchased and hung on the wall for easy access. One is *under the AED cabinet*, one in the *main kitchen* by the sink, and one by the *downstairs bathrooms* near the Sunday School area. They can be removed when in use and restocked as needed. Two smaller kits are available in the kitchenette by the lounge and in the kitchen in the top drawer by the coffee pot.
