First Reading: Exodus 32:7-14

⁷The LORD said to Moses, "Go down at once! Your people, whom you brought up out of the land of Egypt, have acted perversely; ⁸they have been quick to turn aside from the way that I commanded them; they have cast for themselves an image of a calf, and have worshiped it and sacrificed to it, and said, 'These are your gods, O Israel, who brought you up out of the land of Egypt!'" ⁹The LORD said to Moses, "I have seen this people, how stiff-necked they are. ¹⁰Now let me alone, so that my wrath may burn hot against them and I may consume them; and of you I will make a great nation."

¹¹But Moses implored the LORD his God, and said, "O LORD, why does your wrath burn hot against your people, whom you brought out of the land of Egypt with great power and with a mighty hand? ¹²Why should the Egyptians say, 'It was with evil intent that he brought them out to kill them in the mountains, and to consume them from the face of the earth'? PARISH HEALTH - Are you getting the sleep you need? Your brain & body have a lot to do while you slumber.—It goes to work restoring itself, the memories of the day are stored away, and there must be time for dreams. To get this work done, the brain keeps a strict schedule, using different segments of sleep. For specific tasks in a scripted pattern. It repeats the pattern throughout the night in a masterpiece of biological orchestration. - Adults need at least 7 hours of sleep to get the work done but many don't get that. (adults over age 65, require 8-9 hours) As many as 70 million adults have sleep disorders. This can take a profound toll on your health—causing diseases or making them worse, such as diabetes, cardiovascular disease, obesity & depression.

Following a few tips for better sleep can make a big difference:

- 1) Keep to a sleep schedule
- 2) Shape your sleep space– keep bedroom dark, quiet, comfortable temperature—it's also a good time for prayer.
- 3) Eliminate screen time in the bedroom
- 4) Watch what you eat and drink—limit alcohol use
- 5) Exercise during the day
- 6) Manage your worries—give them all to God!
- 7) Limit naps
- 8) Adjust as you age—limit fluids to decrease bathroom trips, may need medications for minor aches/pain If these tips don't help—there are doctors who specialize in sleep disorders so a visit to one is not a bad idea. Wishing you sweet dreams every night—God's Blessing & Peace—Parish Health
