

The book of Revelation is written to seven churches in western Asia Minor during a time of great oppression. Today's reading is a response to the question asked in 6:17: "Who is able to stand?" The writer gives the faithful the assurance of God's protection and a vision of victory.

<sup>9</sup>After this I looked, and there was a great multitude that no one could count, from every nation, from all tribes and peoples and languages, standing before the throne and before the Lamb, robed in white, with palm branches in their hands. <sup>10</sup>They cried out in a loud voice, saying,

"Salvation belongs to our God who is seated on the throne, and to the Lamb!"

<sup>11</sup>And all the angels stood around the throne and around the elders and the four living creatures, and they fell on their faces before the throne and worshiped God, <sup>12</sup>singing,

#### **PARISH HEALTH NOTES -**

The Child Mind Institute, a leading independent nonprofit organization in children's mental health, launched a powerful mental health awareness campaign "YOU GOT THIS!" last May. In this campaign, celebrities and influencers share stories about the mental health disorders, doubts, and confusion they faced when they were young. Most importantly, they offer an empowering vote of confidence that while things may be hard now, "YOU GOT THIS!" Recently Carson Daly from the Today show shared his experiences with his anxiety disorder with a young teen who shared that diagnosis along with OCD. This campaign strives to reduce stigmas and normalize conversations around emotional, social and psychological challenges among youth. With today's teenagers experiencing alarming levels of hopelessness and suicide thoughts, the need for open conversations around mental health is greater than ever before.

Symptoms of depression and anxiety have doubled since the pandemic, and one in five children and teens struggle with a diagnosable mental health disorder. Almost two-thirds of children with a mental disorder don't get identified or treated. Clinical practices and research show that when kids feel comfortable sharing, they have a better chance of receiving life-changing treatment. This campaign seeks to empower children across the country to thrive in the face of adversity and amplify hope.

"Advice For Talking About Mental Health Challenges" and "How To Help Kids Talk About Their Mental Health" tip sheets are available in the information holder on the wall by the northeast entrance of the church.





It's that time of year again! **Operation Christmas Child** is in full swing! I would like to encourage everyone to help fill at least one box! Or if you would like to donate items you can do that also! There are drop off boxes throughout the church for your items. Monetary donations are also welcomed to help with shipping cost, or we can use the money to buy items to fill more boxes. A small shoebox can have a big impact. What goes into the box is fun, but what comes out of it is eternal. Be a part of changing lives through the power of a simple gift.

#### **Gift Suggestions:**

**TOYS** or a "WOW" item: Include items that children will immediately embrace such as dolls, toy cars, stuffed animals, kazoos, harmonicas, yo-yos, jump ropes, balls, toys that light up and make noise (with extra batteries), etc.

**SCHOOL SUPPLIES:** pens, pencils and sharpeners, crayons, markers, notebooks, paper, solar calculators, coloring, and picture books, etc.

**PERSONAL CARE ITEMS:** toothbrushes, bar soap, combs, washcloths, adhesive bandages (Colorful ones can help a child be more willing to wear a bandage. Do not include liquid antibiotic ointment.), Reusable plastic containers: cup, water bottle, plate, bowl, (Consider filling an empty container with non-liquid items such as hair bows, bracelets, sunglasses, or washcloths to maximize the space.) blanket, non-liquid lip balm, nail clipper and file, etc.

CLOTHING & ACCESSORIES: t-shirts, socks, hats, sunglasses, hair clips, jewelry, watches, flashlights (with extra batteries), etc.

**CRAFTS & ACTIVITIES:** Puzzles, Binoculars, Compass, Chalkboard, and chalk, Sewing kit, fabric (1-2 yards), and ribbon, Laminated decorative pictures with looped ribbon attached as a picture hanger, Gardening kit with gloves and trowel hand tool (Do not include gardening seeds.), Playing cards, Skipping rope/Jump rope

**A PERSONAL NOTE:** You may enclose a note to the child and a photo of yourself or your family. If you include your name and address, the child may be able to write back.

DO NOT INCLUDE: Candy; toothpaste; gum; used or damaged items; war-related items such as toy guns, knives, or military figures; chocolate or food; seeds; fruit rolls or other fruit snacks; drink mixes (powdered or liquid); liquids or lotions; medications or vitamins; breakable items such as snow globes or glass containers; aerosol cans.

Shoe boxes are available in the west hallway. We will also have totes for you to drop off your donations.
